CGFM is the premiere respected credential that recognizes the specialized knowledge and experience needed to be an effective government financial manager. Being a CGFM allows you to expand your career opportunities and distinguishes you from others in your field.

CGFM Education Requirements:

To take any of the CGFM examinations, you must have a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university. <u>CGFM Professional Experience Requirements:</u>

CGFM candidates must have at least two years of professional-level experience in government financial management prior to being awarded their designation as a CGFM.
