IN THE NEWS

Crypto users may soon have to report their gains and/or losses on a new tax form. The IRS has proposed Form 1099-DA, meant to help taxpayers determine if they owe taxes and avoid having to make complicated calculations to determine gains.

The proposed rule by the Treasury Department would also require digital asset brokers to send the form to the IRS and the asset holders to assist them in their tax preparation.

The Treasury Department is accepting feedback on the proposed rule until October 30. Public hearings will be held November 7-8.
