Volunteer Tax Income Assistance – 2020 Tax Season

For more than ten years, Greater Columbus AGA has supported the Volunteer Tax Income Assistance sites at both Northland and West HS in Columbus. Volunteers across Central Ohio work at numerous sites to prepare tax returns for low to moderate income families.

Despite the pandemic, the work continues this tax season! United Way of Central Ohio is organizing virtual tax preparation this year and seeking volunteers who are interested in volunteering. Clients will be able to make tax appointments through 2-1-1 and GetYourRefund.Org, and our tax preparers will be virtually preparing their returns via an online platform called "The Hub" and contacting them via phone as needed to ask questions and go over their return with them.

Similar to prior years, all volunteers must be certified by the IRS. This is the first step before you schedule time to volunteer. Each volunteer must pass the Volunteer Standards of Conduct, Intake/Interview, and Advance Tax Certification at <u>https://www.linklearncertification.com/d/</u>. This will generate a Form 13615, which can be submitted to prove you're good to go! Note: if you are an active CPA, you can take the Circular 230 Exam, which just tests on the most recent tax updates. In addition, the training courses (excluding Circular 230) do qualify for CPE (not CET, since tax related).
