Lincoln AGA Chapter Meeting Minutes for April, 2020

Due to the CV19 social distancing guidelines, there was no Chapter meeting conducted in April of 2020.

Lincoln Chapter CEC Minutes – April 30, 2020

Because of the current environment and social distancing guidelines, the CEC met via conference call. A quorum participated.

Our President, Ann Martinez, called the meeting to order. She conducted a roll call of CEC members to make sure we had a quorum. Eight members were on the call.

First item discussed was the CEC slate for the 20-21 year. We still have vacancies, including Director(s) of Education – Meetings, Director of Accountability and Outreach, Director of Professional Development Training (PDT), and Director of Professional Certification. Ann made the motion to approve this slate of officers, Tim Channer seconded the motion, and the motion passed. Normally the slate would have been submitted to Chapter membership before the May Chapter meeting to be voted on then. Under these circumstances, Ann will send an email to members with this slate and ask for nominations to fill vacancies by a certain date. The CEC agreed this process needs to be done over the next few weeks and certainly by May 31. The CEC will meet again on May 20. Usually the CEC has a planning retreat in June. Ann will give this some thought; we may do this online using Zoom.

Ann reported on the Chapter Recognition Program. Despite a cutback in activities it looks like the Chapter will again achieve the Platinum Award.

The national AGA LEAD! 2020 event, scheduled for early May, was cancelled not to be rescheduled. The national AGA PDT in Dallas will be conducted exclusively online. This

will be conducted July 20-22. Total sessions will be reduced from 90 to 48, the cost will be \$550 (\$500 by June 19) for members and for non-members \$650 (\$600 by June 19). Total available CPE will be 21 hours.

Our fall Chapter PDT was then discussed. With so many uncertainties, by consensus the matter was tabled with no action taken.

There were no reports discussed for Meetings, Membership & Young Professionals, Accountability & Outreach, Communications, Professional Certification, Community Service, and Bylaws. The next Chapter meeting will be in September. Ann shared the list of members not renewing membership so far. Because of CV19 the deadline to renew has been extended to April 30 with the usual grace period following, too. An updated list will be generated and CEC members will be asked to call members whom they know on this list to encourage renewal. Jessica Elliott commented that the Bowl-a-thon went well but we could have used a couple more members involved. The deadline to get an article to Tim Channer for the next Chapter newsletter will be May 5.

Tim Baker spoke on Corporate Sponsorships. The three sponsorships have remitted their total of \$6.500 payments. Some discussion followed about the lack of a May PDT and if Baker has received any feedback from the sponsors to which Baker said there has been no feedback.

The Chapter Treasurer, Dan Albrecht, presented the February and March Treasurer's Reports. One question was asked by Baker. He asked about the third Corporate Sponsorship payment. Dan explained it was received but not deposited till April. Staci moved acceptance of the February report, Baker seconded, and motion passed. Baker moved acceptance of the March report, Jessica seconded, and the motion passed.

Ken said that the March Chapter and CEC minutes had been published in the March Newsletter and asked if there were any needed changes. Hearing none, Ann moved and Channer seconded acceptance of the meeting minutes, which motion passed.
