What is the CGFM?



The Mark of Excellence for Government Financial Professionals

CGFM is a professional certification recognizing the unique skills and special knowledge required of today's government financial managers. It covers governmental accounting, auditing, financial reporting, internal controls and budgeting at the federal, state and local levels.

Interested in the CGFM Certification? You will need to study for the exams!

The Ozarks AGA has a set of current study guides available for checkout—one book at a time for 2 months at a time. They are in three separate three-ring binders – one for each section.

If you are interested in borrowing one of the study guides, would like to participate in a study group, or have questions about the CGFM program, please notify Tina McManus at tinamcmanus@missouristate.edu and she will answer any questions you have, or arrange for you to check it out when it becomes available.

One of the benefits of being a member of our Ozarks Chapter is that we will reimburse you for the successful passing of the CGFM exam in its entirety if you meet qualifications.

Also—members receive a \$29 discount off the price of the application fee!


CGFM FAQ: How long is the eligibility Period?

A: You have (3) years from the date your application is processed to pass the (3) CGFM examinations.

CGFM FAQ: My eligibility period ends soon—can I get an exension?

A: If your eligibility period ends before you pass all three CGFM examinations, you will need to reapply and pass all the examinations again. Extensions of eligibility may be granted to individuals who passed some, but not all, of their examinations. No extensions will be granted to individuals who have not passed any of their CGFM examinations.


