THE 2022 PDT- UPDATE

October 17 and 18, 2022

You have spoken and we have listened. Survey results after the 2021 PDT indicated 34.6% prefer live conferences, 43.6% prefer virtual, and 21.8% do not have a preference.

Hopefully, to satisfy 100% of your needs, the 38th Annual Professional Development Training Conference will also be the 1st Hybrid Conference.

We will be returning to the Quest Conference Center for an in-person conference and hope to see most of you in-person again. The Quest Conference Center has moved to a new location 9200 Worthington Rd, Westerville, OH; however, this is just down the road from their old location.

In the past, it was cost prohibitive to run a hybrid event with both in-person and virtual. Thanks to Dr. Toby Groves who presented some Ethics sessions for us in the past, he has offered equipment and services at an affordable price for us to host an in-person conference while streaming for those who still prefer to attend virtually. We plan for the in-person conference to be in a similar format as the past with some general sessions for everyone and some sessions which will run concurrently as three break-out sessions where you can choose the topic to attend. For those who elect to attend virtually, we will only be able to live stream one of the break-out sessions. More reason to attend in-person if you are able, for a wider selection of sessions to choose from.

We will provide similar options for breakfast and lunch along with refreshments during breaks included trying to bring back the ever popular Greater's Ice Cream.

We are hoping to return to the PDT Conference format as you remember from the past.

We believe the 2022 will deliver an excellent professional training experience over the 2 days, Monday October 17 and Tuesday October 18, 2022, providing up to 16 hours of CPE for those who need it, at a bargain price. We are still finalizing fees for this year's conference with the expectation they will be similar to 2019 fees from our last in-person conference and we will offer reduced early bird fees for those who register early and also reduced fees for those who are members of AGA.

We have confirmed a few of our popular topics and speakers from the past including:

- R. Kinney Poynter, NASACT Executive Director will return to present his Emerging Issues in Government Accounting and Auditing
- Mike Glynn will present an AICPA Update
- Lisa Parker will present a GASB Update
- Dr. Toby Groves will present his 3 hour Ethics Training at our conference this year which meets the CPA licensure requirements and we are hoping to have Dr. Groves for an additional session

Visit our website and watch for email blasts with more information as it becomes available. We hope to have a brochure ready and open registration by mid-summer. For now, save the dates of October 17 and 18, 2022 for this year's PDT with both an inperson or virtual option. In the meantime, as always, the Education Committee can use dedicated volunteers. CGFM MONTH

The Central Ohio Chapter of AGA received the State of Ohio Proclamation for the month of March being recognized as CGFM month from the Ohio Governor's office on February 25th.



WHEREAS, the Association of Government Accountants (AGA) is a professional organization with a network of 14,000 members in 90 chapters in the United States and around the world and approximately 520 active members representing state, federal, local and private sector government accountability professionals; and

WHEREAS, AGA Central Ohio Chapter members have responded to AGA's mission of advancing government accountability, as it continues its broad educational efforts, with emphasis on high standards of conduct, honor, and character in its Code of Ethics, and are making significant advances both in professional ability and in service to the citizens of Ohio by mastering increasingly technical and complex requirements, and

WHEREAS, the Certified Government Financial Manager (CGFM) program of AGA provides a means of demonstrating professionalism and competency by requiring CGFM candidates to have appropriate educational and employment history, to abide by AGA's Code of Ethics and to pass three examinations requiring expertise in Governmental Environment, Governmental Financial Management and Control, and Governmental Accounting, Financial Reporting and Budgeting, and requires each CGFM holder to maintain certification by completing at least 80 hours of continuing professional education in government financial management topics or related technical subjects every two years.
