Tips for Preparing for CGFM Exams:

Begin by reviewing the CGFM examinations content outlines, which list the main and subtopics covered in each examination. This should be the focal point of your preparation. It is the core document used as the basis for each examination and a guideline for writing examination questions.

Once you are ready to begin studying for the exam, there are a variety of ways to approach it. You can utilize all, or part of these resources. The AGA offers instructor led courses. You can attend an instructor led course in the Washington, D.C. area, or participate in an intensive review course at the annual AGA PDT.

Even if you take the instructor led courses, you will want to perform some self-study following this, in order to prepare yourself for the exams. CGFM study guides are available for purchase through AGA National, in hard copy, or as a soft copy. Spend time reviewing these materials and answering the questions from each section of the study guides. Also, the Phoenix Chapter, has CGFM study guides available for check out.

AGA also now offers three online CGFM practice examinations, which will help you prepare to take the real exam. These practice examinations, are a must.

Study groups can also be helpful. If you know others that are preparing to take the same exam, you can meet regularly to test each others knowledge, and support each other in the journey. Consider joining the AGA Phoenix Chapter study group. To find out more, e-mail <u>contact@agaphoenix.org</u>.
