The AICPA and NASBA are proposing a competency-based experience pathway for CPA licensure.

This additional pathway would require candidates to be evaluated on seven professional competencies and at least one of three technical competencies.

The competencies would be verified in the workplace by licensed CPAs.

Public input on the proposed pathway can be submitted until December 6.
