

The Senior Accountant classification performs complex accounting work in all areas of financial reporting, including the preparation of the Annual Comprehensive Financial Report and Capital Projects. Additionally, this classification provides high-level technical support and coordination for the City Treasurer's Office, working effectively with City management and external stakeholders.

Experience and Education:

- A Bachelor's Degree in Accounting, Finance, Business Administration, or closely related field from an accredited educational institution.
- Five years of experience in accounting, financial cost analysis, financial forecasting, auditing, or a closely related financial/fiscal activity.
- Current professional certification as an Arizona Certified Public Accountant is required within six months of employment.
- Every person employed by the City of Scottsdale shall reside in the State of Arizona during his or her active employment by the City, regardless of whether the employee is approved to remote work.

Other pertinent licenses and/or certifications may be required of some positions depending on department/section assignment.
