




Inside Story...YOU!







- Discussed:
 - President: Program year goals; Meeting date preferences
 - RVP: Governance structure will be discussed during PDT social hour on Thursday; Storage solution offered by National—requested on 11/3/17; New chapter—Corrine & Randy working with Longwood University to establish a student chapter; SLM will be held in Baltimore on May 3-5.
