
> Mentoring Program

- Provides financial analysis of special projects and proposals to management.

Minimum Qualifications: Bachelor's degree in Accounting, Economics, Business Administration, Public Administration, or closely related field; AND five (5) years of experience in accounting, financial cost analysis, financial forecasting, auditing, or a closely related financial/fiscal activity ;OR, an equivalent combination of education and experience may substitute for the educational requirements on a year-for-year basis.
