- President discussed goals for the program year:
 - Continue getting members 40CPE per year
 - Continue on our streak of obtaining platinum at National PDT
 - Get members more involved and engaged at sessions and CEC
 - Complete a CCR report for 2017-18
 - Increase membership and explore more opportunities to promote AGA
- Discussion:
