WHAT IS CGFM?

Certified Government Financial Manager® (CGFM®) is a professional certification awarded by AGA, demonstrating competency in governmental accounting, auditing, financial reporting, internal controls and budgeting at the federal, state and local levels.

CGFM is a respected credential that recognizes the specialized knowledge and experience needed to be an effective government financial manager.

Being a CGFM allows you to expand your career opportunities and distinguishes you from others in your field.

WHAT IS THE CGFM **CERTIFICATION PROCESS?**

Step 1 — Read AGA's Code of Ethics Step 2 — Apply for the CGFM Program Step 3 — Submit Required Degree **Documentation** Step 4 — Receive an Eligibility Letter Step 5 — Prepare for the CGFM **Examinations** Step 6 — Schedule the CGFM **Examinations** Step 7 — Take the CGFM **Examinations** Step 8 — Submit a Work **Verification Form** Step 9 — Receive CGFM Award Letter Step 10 — Receive Your CGFM **Certificate and Maintain Your** Certification

The application for the Program will be placed on AGA-Trenton website shortly. The scholarship recipient will be announced and introduced at AGA-Trenton's annual Award Dinner in May 2023.
