Survey:

Our chapter has been asked to forward a link to a survey on sexual harassment within the government accounting profession. This is for a research study being conducted by accounting faculty at Loyola University Chicago. The purpose of this study is to revisit the socially unacceptable behavior of sexual harassment in government accounting. The survey should take no more than 15 minutes. The involvement of accounting professionals from government sectors and at different points in their careers will better help the research team determine how pervasive the problem of sexual harassment is and whether it is focused at employees at certain levels or in certain industries. Responses are confidential, survey data will be encrypted, results of the study will only be published in the aggregate, and no personally identifiable information would be solicited in the survey. Minimum Qualifications: Bachelor's degree in Accounting, Finance, Business Administration, or a closely related field; AND five (5) years of responsible experience performing the payroll functions including two years of supervisory experience; OR, an equivalent combination of education and experience sufficient to successfully perform the essential duties.
