### **Community Service**

The Foundation for Lincoln City Libraries Book Sale is held once a year. All proceeds from the book sale go back to Lincoln City Libraries. They would not be able to hold the sale each year without the wonderful volunteers that show up to help.

The book sale offers the opportunity for communities in Nebraska and surrounding areas to purchase books for their own collections, their children's collections, teacher's classrooms, businesses and so many more places without having to spend a fortune. Author Neil Gaiman said it best, "A book is a dream you hold in your hand".

The Sale is held at the Lancaster Event Center Monday September 18, 2019 thru Sunday September 22, 2019. They have over 150,000 books delivered in boxes. Volunteers are needed starting on Monday, September 16. Monday – Wednesday they need volunteers to unload the books from the boxes and set them out on the tables. They also need help setting out signs on the tables and setting up checkout stations. Wednesday evening is the first day the Book Sale is open for a private fundraising event and Thursday – Sunday is free and open to the public. Wednesday Evening- Sunday Afternoon volunteers would organize the books on tables, assist customers with finding books, help carrying carts of books or boxes, help with check-out, and with the carry-out of purchases. Once the sale is over on Sunday afternoon, they need volunteers to help with boxing books that didn't sell and tearing down any leftover boxes to be recycled. This is a great way for AGA to support Lincoln City Libraries and our community.

## **Lincoln Chapter CEC Meeting Minutes – August 21, 2019**

The meeting was called to order by Ann Martinez, President. Others attending included: Tim Baker, Tim Channer, Jeff Filbert, Adam Brown, Staci Bolton, Char Scott, Dan Albrecht, and Ken Rouch. A quorum was present.

The first order of business was discussion of the vacancy of the Director of Professional Certification. By consensus the CEC decided to perform these duties as a "committee of the whole" unless and until someone steps up to fill the position. Most of the activity is in March anyway. The office of President-elect is still vacant as well.

The next order of business was Education. Char announced the fall PDT will be 9-12-19 at Innovation Campus. Registration is available on the Chapter website; so far we have 25 registrants. A variety of topics and speakers are lined up for this event. Char also mentioned she is considering a spring PDT for May and using Darrell Dorrell, a forensics attorney.

Since Ralene was not present Tim B. mentioned there is a webinar on Internal Control available in October. Baker moved and Staci seconded the motion to register for this webinar, if the conference room at 1526 K Building is available. (Secretary's note, this room

is not available so this webinar will not be used.) Other webinars don't yet have adequate descriptions to decide to use them.

Jeff reported the regular monthly Chapter meeting will be 9-18-19 at Tico's. The speaker will be Don Onwiler, Executive Director at the National Conference of Weights and Measures. His topic will be the work of his agency. The October meeting will be on the  $2^{nd}$  at Misty's. The speaker will be Dawn Lindsley who will speak on her work with the Nebraska Department of Education.

Next up Membership and Young Professionals was discussed. Frank was not present, but Ann shared information about UNL's Beta Alpha Psi programs for the year. No action was taken.

For Accountability & Outreach Ann mentioned the Citizen Centric Report is due to national on September 30.

For Communications Tim C reported articles for the next newsletter can be sent to him by 8-27-19. Staci had no report for websites.

For Professional Certification Ann reported what the new study guides would cost, accordingly: Vol. 1 - \$95, Vol. 2- \$115, and, Vol. 3 - \$105. A member of our Chapter has expressed interest in pursuing the exam. Discussion followed concerning alternatives such as buying online courses. No action was taken. (Secretary's note, since this CEC meeting, by using email, Ann made the motion to buy the hard copy of each volume, Jeff seconded the motion, and the motion carried. The volumes will be bought and provided to any member who wants to sit for the exams.)

Concerning Community Service, the article about the activity to help the Library Foundation with books will be republished in the newsletter as dates in the previous article were incorrect.

Sponsorships were discussed. Tim B reported that Infor will send three individuals to attend the September PDT. Char reported they asked for an hour to make remarks which they will be allowed to do.

Dan presented the Treasurer's Report covering June and July. Our ending checking account balance is \$11,432.64. Channer moved approval of this report, Ken seconded, and motion passed. Dan also reported that Frank filed the Chapter's annual Form 990 to the IRS by the due date in August. Ann mentioned we still need to line up someone to perform an audit of finances for last year.

Ken reported the minutes of the July 19 CEC meeting were published in the newsletter. Their approval was moved by Char, seconded by Baker, and passed.

There were no reports by Past President nor Director of Bylaws.

Ken reported that progress has not been made concerning the subject of Chapter fundraising strategy. This will be tabled until the September CEC meeting.

Ann adjourned the meeting.
