- Minimizing Recipient Burden
- Grant Reach
  - Underserved communities and health equity
- Award Saturation and Responsiveness
- Procurement Limitations/Hesitancies
  - Emergency response procedures
  - Staff recruitment and sustainment
- Data Reporting



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### **Assistance Mechanisms**

- New Grant Mechanisms
  - Crisis Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) structured to allow CDC to obligate funds expeditiously during a declared public health emergency to states and territories
  - Compressed NOFO development timeline
- Existing Grant Mechanisms
  - Leverage mechanisms with commonly needed or like activities
  - Emergency language and or components incorporated for use as needed
    - Unfunded components that address public health emergency (PHE) and/or containment of infectious disease outbreaks
- Each Act (e.g., ARP) is given its own unique identifier in an award to allow for tracking/monitoring



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## **Risk Mitigation Activities**

- Pre-award Conference Calls
- Funds tracking by unique identifier
  - Each Act's (e.g., ARP) funding is given its own unique identifier in an award to allow for tracking/monitoring
- Special Award Conditions
  - Enhanced data collection and reporting
- Increased Oversight
  - Internal Control Reviews
  - External audits
