




Cyber Civics: Introduction




Cyber Civics: Social Media 101

- 2. Audience: Who is your audience?
- 3. Social Media Landscape: What are the different platforms, their functions, and users' demographics?

- **4. Readiness level**: To which extent is your organization ready to be exposed and engaged in a conversation?
- 5. Resources: Assess your human, financial and time resources before indulging in a stretched social media strategy that you can't maintain
- 6. Industry Social Media Behavior: Benchmark and look for behaviors, trends, and best practices



- 7. Infrastructure: Is your organization ready to integrate social media within other existing communications channels
- **8. Data Analysis**: What are you using to measure analytics?
- 9. Set a Strategy: It is critical to incorporate social media in the overall communications strategy and have clear targets and expectations.
- **10. Auditing Parameters**: Revise your social media presence periodically


Social Media Strategy Do...

- 1. Create a Social Media Policy & Procedure with your legal team that addresses comments and monitoring tactics
- 2. Know your audience
- Engage them with specific CTAs!
- 4. Write in first person.
- Use pictures, videos or infographics in ALL posts. Ex: visual.ly



Social Media Strategy Do...

- 6. "Pick your battles"
- 7. Respond to most posts even the naysayers!
- 8. Play nice with others. Remember YOU are representing your organization.
- Give Props & Shout Outs

Social Media Strategy DON'T...

1. Waste your audience's time.

2. Disable or Delete comments unless they have broken any of your social media policies.

3. Plagiarize. It's the LAW!



Social Media Strategy DON'T...

4. Offend anyone or post negative comments! Remember you are representing you organization

Post when in doubt. Always call your legal team with questions & concerns

6. Make political or religious comments on behalf of your organization.



Social Media Strategy Don't

- 7. Don't over use the hashtags... #that! ©
- 8. Forget social media is always on... even when you're out of the office
- Ignore real time events that could attract a new audience
- 10.Get overwhelmed. The social media machine is evolving constantly.

- We weren't being strategic.
- We had our Facebook linked to our Twitter account Not a good idea!

Murder Suspect Arrested

On February 18, 2014, at approximately 7:15 am, Pedro Calixto-Velenta was seen falling from a white Chevy Blazer in the 7900 block of the LBJ service road. A suspect driving the Blazer continued driving and was involved in an accident in the 12200 block of Coit Road where he abandoned the vehicle and fled on foot. Velenta had been stabbed multiple times.

Velenta was transported to Medical City Hospital where he was pronounced deceased. Crime Scene Response Unit processed the Blazer and inside two bank receipts were found showing transactions occurring earlier in the day. Velenta's cell phone was also found in the vehicle and text messages were found on the phone that appeared to indicate Velenta was arguing with someone.

Research into the phone number from which the texts were sent showed the number came from an individual named Gaspar Enciso, L/m/01-05-1997. Surveillance footage from the bank showed Velenta and Enciso withdrawing money. Witnesses were shown still images from the video and identified Enciso as the man with Velenta during the transactions.

The officers heard a female and a male yelling for help in the parking lot. When they went to investigate, the officers discovered a woman going into active labor in the parking lot.

Officer Glass ran to get medical assistance while Officer Hernandez stayed with the couple.

Officer Hernandez saw that the baby's head was crowning and quickly removed her police jacket to catch the baby and to keep it warm. The man who was with the woman wanted to pull the baby out before the woman had completely

delivered it. However, Officer Hernandez prevented this, thus saving the baby and the woman from any bodily injury.

Officer Hernandez kept the woman calm throughout the entire delivery process and wrapped the baby in her jacket to keep it warm. Officer Hernandez continued to calm the couple until Officer Glass returned with hospital staff.
