The Chapter provides a variety of educational programs, volunteer events, and other professional development opportunities for its members.

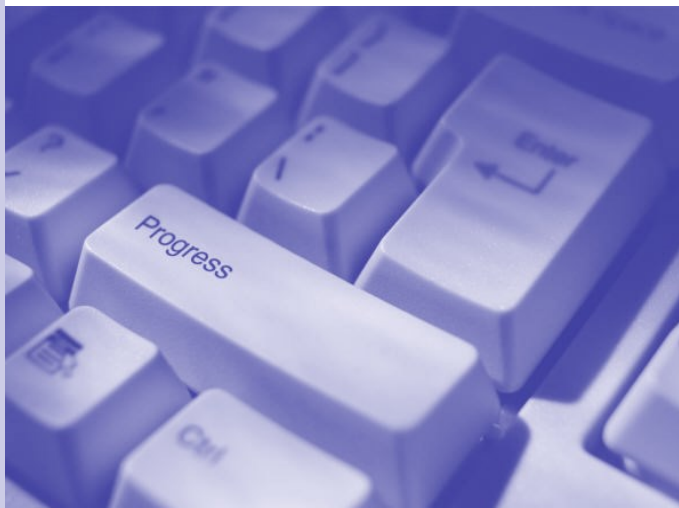
We believe that providing quality programming to our members allows them to increase their service, and reduce costs to customers. For many members, these customers are our men and women serving in uniform.

## Certification: The Mark of Excellence



AGA offers its members the opportunity to pursue the *Certified Government Financial Manager* (CGFM) certification. Since 1994, this has been the standard in the field of government financial management.

The CGFM committee of the AGA Indianapolis Chapter provides study sessions for each of the 3 examination modules, flash cards, and additional resources for members. To-date 127 Indianapolis Chapter members have become certified!

Resources and exams cost over \$600 for those who intend to pursue the CGFM. This is just one example that illustrates how additional funds can enhance the impact our Chapter has on members, taxpayers, and customers.

### Silver Corporate Sponsorship - \$1000+ per year

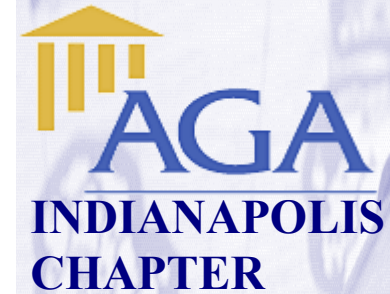
Silver Sponsors receive a medium logo on our website along with a quarter-page ad in the newsletter.
